What Orthodontists can do to improve Smile Aesthetics with 3D Technology.

Two major limitations can be found when looking at conventional straight wire techniques; the methodology used to develop the concepts on which they are based being the first. Likewise, none of them take into consideration the relationship between teeth and their biological environment; that is, the relative position of the root with respect to the supporting alveolar and cortical bone.

However, these biological aspects are closely correlated with two other essential keystones of ideal orthodontic objectives: function and esthetics. In this course it will be analyzed the importance of anterior and posterior torque in occlusion, smile esthetics and biology taking advantage of the latest 3D Technology.
